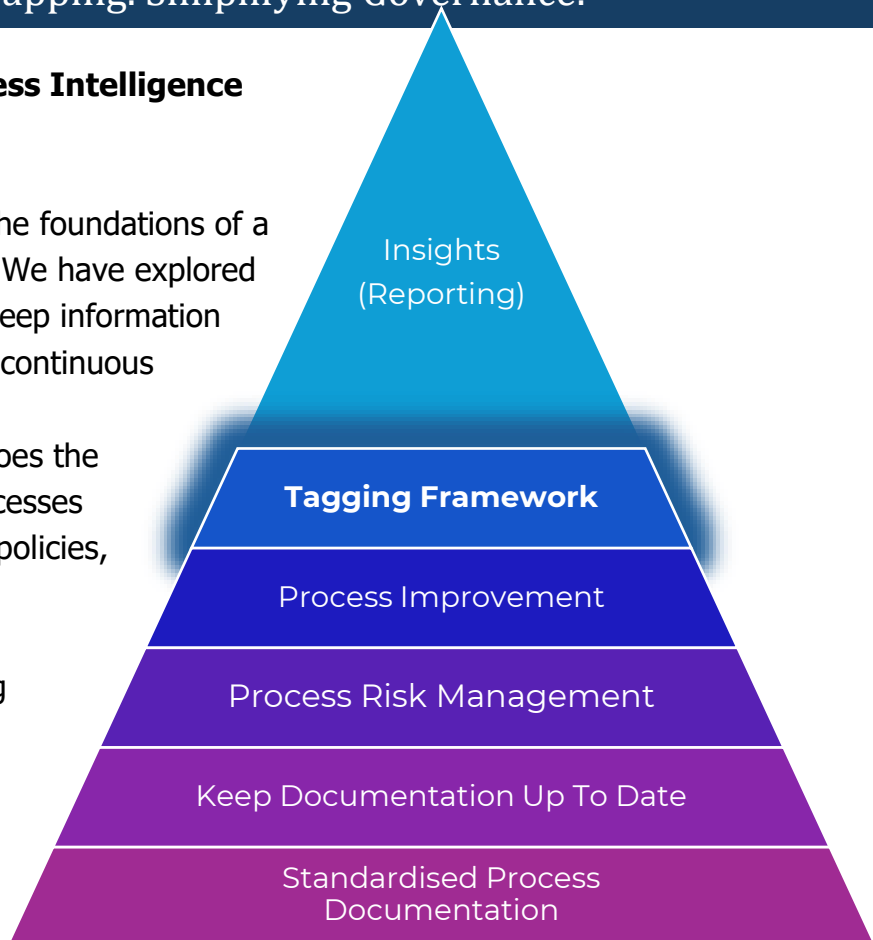
Welcome to the sixth edition of your **Process Intelligence Companion** newsletter series.

Tagging Framework

Why Structure Matters

Most organisations accumulate vast amounts of process information over time.

Processes end up connected to:

- departments,
- applications,
- controls,
- risks,
- business units,
- regulatory requirements,
- roles and responsibilities.

Without a structured way to classify this information, finding answers becomes difficult and reporting becomes time-consuming. Most organisations rely on spreadsheets, naming conventions, or manual categorisation to organise their process data. As the process landscape grows, these approaches become increasingly difficult to maintain.

This is where BluePrintBI's **Tagging Framework** creates value.

1. Organise Processes Beyond Traditional Hierarchies

Process hierarchies are excellent for showing how work flows through an organisation.

But what if you want to see:

- all activities affected by a compliance requirement,
- every process earmarked for automation,
- all tasks performed by a system or robot,
- all processes supporting a specific product or customer segment.

Traditional hierarchies cannot answer these questions easily. BluePrintBI allows information to be tagged across multiple dimensions, making it possible to view the same process landscape from different perspectives.

 **BluePrintBI Tip:** Think of tags as creating additional pathways through your process landscape. A single process can belong to multiple categories without needing to duplicate the tags.

2. Build a Process Language Everyone Understands

One of the biggest challenges in business process management is inconsistency. Different teams often use different terminology for the same concept.

Examples include:

- system names,
- business units,
- risk categories,
- compliance requirements,
- improvement initiatives.

BluePrintBI's structured tagging framework helps standardise how information is classified across the organisation for various purposes. This creates a consistent process language that improves collaboration, reporting, and governance.

 **BluePrintBI Tip:** Define tag ownership upfront. Consistent tagging standards deliver significantly more value than large volumes of unstructured tags.

3. Accelerate Reporting and Analysis

The real power of tagging appears when information needs to be analysed or audited.

Instead of manually gathering information from multiple sources, tagged data allows organisations to quickly identify:

- processes associated with specific regulations,
- applications supporting critical activities,
- risks across business units,
- controls linked to compliance obligations,
- improvement initiatives across departments.

Questions that once required hours of manual investigation can often be answered in seconds. Tagging transforms process information into searchable business intelligence.

 **BluePrintBI Tip:** Start with a few high-value tags and expand naturally as reporting requirements evolve.

4. Strengthen Governance and Compliance

Governance depends on visibility.

For organisations managing multiple regulatory requirements, audits often begin with questions such as:

- Which processes support this regulation?
- Where are the associated controls?
- Who owns the processes involved?
- Which applications are impacted?

With the BluePrintBI Tagging Framework, these relationships are captured and maintained as part of the process landscape.

This improves:

- audit readiness,
